



- Bradford ARC has a compact, picturesque stretch of water and a clubhouse with good changing facilities, giving an inclusive atmosphere for both competitors and spectators. The Club is particularly keen to encourage new and inexperienced competitors of all ages.
- Primary Regattas are specifically intended for the less experienced competitor and aims to give them the opportunity to race opponents of a similar standard.
- It is intended to race in blocks i.e. winner stays on the water for subsequent races.
- **Please note bowloaders cannot be accommodated for safety reasons – if this presents a problem please ask about borrowing a boat.**
- All doubling (competitors **AND** equipment) to be notified to the Regatta Secretary before the draw. **Please note that doubling within a division of either competitors, boats or equipment is not allowed.**
- Racing will be organised in 3 divisions to facilitate doubling of both competitors and equipment. The suggested plan is as follows, subject to final entries, when changes may be made:
