

Dear Club Representative,

Thank you for your entries to Bradford Autumn Regatta.

Your safety has always been our priority and at our event on 18th September we are making the following changes to make sure you and your Club's visiting competitors remain as safe as possible during these weird times:

- Each club will be required provide a single point of contact who will provide their contact details and sign a declaration that their Club has not brought any competitors, or others, who have any symptoms of COVID-19, have a recent positive COVID-19 test or have been 'pinged' by Track and Trace
- Club points of contacts will agree to contact BARC if anyone in attendance subsequently tests positive and will pass on any alerts from BARC post-regatta to all attendees
- We are NOT encouraging the attendance of spectators. Regular attendees will be aware of our restricted bank space and we wish to try and maintain appropriate social distancing where possible
- We will refund any entry fees for competitors who have to comply with government guidelines around Track and Trace and self-isolation and will permit additional substitutions as required
- Our building will operate one way system – the tea stall upstairs will be accessed by the front stairs only. Routes will be clearly signposted
- Our changing rooms will be available; however, we request that changing is kept an absolute minimum

Your continued support and attendance at our regatta is, as always, greatly appreciated and we hope you enjoy a grand day's racing on the River Aire.
